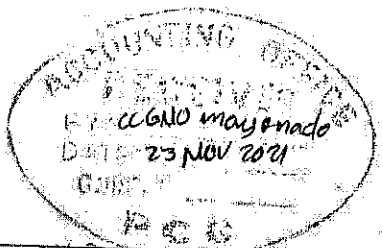

- Inspection and acceptance shall be conducted by the authorized representatives of the end-user, Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) and/or other offices/body authorized by the Philippine Coast Guard.
 - The inspections and tests that will be conducted include, but not limited to inspection for the completeness of the requirements in accordance with the required quantity of the procurement requirement and compliance to all parameters of the Technical Specifications/Scope of Work/Terms of Reference at the project site.
 - The goods shall be accepted only by the end user after passing the inspection and acceptance.
 - Non-compliance and/or any identified defects with any parameters of the Technical Specifications and/or delay in the completion or delivery of the requirements based on the provisions of the Schedule of Requirements shall be reported to the Philippine Coast Guard for appropriate penalties and/or sanctions.

WARRANTY PERIOD / COVERAGE OF WARRANTY:

99% of the costs of the items delivered subject to the Philippine Coast Guard's acceptance [issuance of the Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR)] in writing.

1% Retention of the items delivered to be paid after three (3) months from the formal acceptance (issuance of the IAR), if and when no patent and latent defects are noted (issuance of a Certificate of No Patent and Latent Defects).

CONTRACT AGREEMENT


THIS AGREEMENT made the 14 day of OCTOBER 2021 between **PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD** with office address at **139 25th Street, Port Area, Manila**, of the Philippines (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and **SQUIRES BINGHAM INTERNATIONAL, INC.** of 179 Boni Serrano Road, Brgy. Socorro, Cubao, Quezon City, Manila (hereinafter called "the Supplier") of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly **Supply and Delivery of Caliber .40 and Shotgun Gauge #12 Ammunition**, and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum **ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS ONLY (Php1,619,580.00)** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - a. Schedule of Requirements;
 - b. Technical Specifications;
 - c. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - d. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
 - iii. Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
 - iv. Performance Security;
 - v. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
 - vi. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
3. In consideration for the sum of **ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS (Php1,619,580.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **SQUIRES BINGHAM INTERNATIONAL, INC.** agrees to **Supply and Delivery of Caliber .40 and Shotgun Gauge #12 Ammunition** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
4. The **PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.

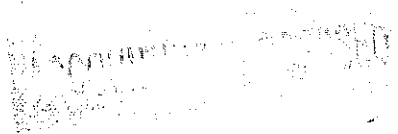

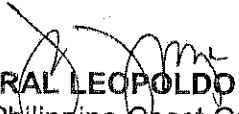
